Schedule:

Event Start, Each Day: **8AM EDT**

Day-of-test entries will be accepted as time allows and will run in the afternoon.

Scheduling will be done in blocks to reduce crowds. We will be using a set run order. Your dog will have ~30 dogs between his two runs (if both tests entered), which equates to about one hour. Multiple dogs with the same owner will be spaced about 10 dogs (~20 min) apart.

Running times of all pre-entered dogs will be emailed to participants after entries close. Please arrive at least 15-20 minutes before your block begins for check-in, inspection, and to warm-up your dog(s).

Use of Squawker:

Handlers will have the option to use a noise-maker, called a squawker, attached with the normal plastic bags for their dog's runs. Please note on your entry form if you would like a squawker or not and you will be grouped accordingly. Sound sensitive dogs may not like this noise – please advise if you want a no-squawker group on your entry form. Squawkers will only be used on dry grass.

Catcher/Releaser & Traveling Partners:

If you have a catcher/releaser who is also entered, or a friend or traveling partner you want to be in the same group with, please note that on your entry form. We'll make sure to assign you to the same group. The Club can provide help catching or releasing if needed – just ask at event.

Field, Facility, and Fencing:

- Mowed grass field.
- The Test run lane is completely fenced for safety.
- Porta-potties are available.
- Dogs not running their event must be leashed or properly confined.
- Please keep the grounds and building clean by picking up after yourself and your dog and disposing of properly. Please keep the test site, grounds, and hotel rooms and grounds clean.

Timing:

Electronic Timers will be used for this event. In the event of a malfunction of the timing equipment or inclement weather, 2 stop watches may be substituted for timing.

Inspection:

All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured, if needed, prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in season prior to running each event. Any entry found during inspection to be unfit to compete, lame, or bitches in season shall be barred from competition and entry fees shall be refunded.

Camping:

There is no overnight parking/camping allowed at the GLKC building. The following RV sites are nearby:

AOK Campground (4 miles): 225 E 300 S, Lafayette, IN 47909 *(*note this is mainly a residential park but they do offer nightly rates)*

Awards:

A light blue strip ribbon will be awarded for each completed run. A New Title Rosette will be given for each new Fast CAT title earned at this event. Awards will not be shipped – please pick them up at the trial. Let us know if you expect to title at our event.

Anyone caught photographing any portion of this event for commercial purposes without permission may be asked to leave.

Volunteers:

We appreciate any extra hands with Friday set-up, Sunday tear-down, and assisting to catch/release dogs for their run.

Concessions:

Fast food restaurants are within driving distance and Arni's Pizza (<https://meetyouatarnis.com/locations/shadeland/>) is located across the street. There will be a short break for lunch.

How Does Fast CAT Work?

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
2. Dogs run singularly.
3. The dog's time to complete the 100 yd dash is converted into mph:

Formula: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

4. Based on the dog's wither height, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0

MPH x HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

- BCAT = 150 points
- DCAT = 500 points
- FCAT = 1,000 points
- FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

5. Timing Devices: The time to complete the 100-yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second. The club may use stopwatches or break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the bottom of the arm drop. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
6. Area of the course will be fenced with a fenced-in recovery area of ~70 yards. To learn more about AKC's Fast CAT please visit AKC Fast CAT webpage: <https://www.akc.org/sports/coursing/fast-cat/>
7. Dogs are not to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. This means you cannot run with your dog (on or off the track). You cannot use toys/treats to get them to come to you as they are running the track. You CAN use your voice and/or hands to encourage them.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

1. Coursing Ability & Fast CAT tests are open to all dogs 12 months of age or older that are individually registered with AKC, recognized foreign registries, possess an FSS number, PAL #, ILP #, or Canine Partner Program number, and open to all sighthounds as well as those with breed disqualifications.
2. Not AKC registered? – NO PROBLEM! You can register your Canine Partner with AKC. Download the registration form here: <http://www.akc.org/dog-owners/canine-partners/enroll/>
3. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, and the Agreement found on the Official AKC Entry Form in this premium.
4. REFUNDS: Bitches in season and lame dogs will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees less the AKC recording fee. Refunds for other absences or withdrawals made after the event entry closing date will not be made.
5. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded less the AKC recording fee.
6. Racing muzzles are allowed. No pinch collars and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed.
7. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
8. The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore s/he is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, s/he has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
9. Any decisions made by the Event officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the Event officials to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Event officials are responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
10. Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
11. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC or GLKC trial volunteers or any dog(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
12. There will be a minimum \$25 returned check charge.
13. GLKC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test. The entire course and run-out area will be fenced. Areas outside of the course are not fenced. Exhibitors must contain and control their dogs at all times.
14. Children MUST be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.
15. Any dog that eliminates on course or in the run-out area will receive a non-qualifying (NQ) score.
16. Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
17. The club, GLKC, its agents, members, representatives, and volunteers assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage, illness, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event. By entering this event, you agree to this provision.
