Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the
start of each class.

Friday (24C" - 4"):

Excellent/Masters Only

FAST (Master/Excellent), Time 2 Beat, Standard (Premier,
Master/Excellent), JWW (Premier, Master/Excellent)

Saturday (4" - 24"):

FAST* (Master/Excellent, Open, Novice A/B)
STD (Premier, Master/Excellent, Open, Novice A/B)
JWW (Master/ Excellent, Open, Novice A/B)

*All FAST courses will be nested. Masters/Excellent will walk then
run. Open and Novice will walk together and then run consecutively.

Sunday (24C" - 4"):

Time 2 Beat, Standard (Masters/Excellent, Open, Novice A/B),
JWW (Premier, Masters/Excellent, Open, Novice A/B)

Email confirmation for receipt of entries will be provided, as well as email confirmation of entry status following the random draw (if needed). If email address is NOT provided and you would like advanced notification of entry status, please include a self-addressed, stamped postcard.

Entry fees for all regular classes are \$19 for the first class and \$19 for each additional class per dog per day. All entry fees include the AKC recording fee.

After Closing Wait List

GLKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Nov. 22, 2024, at 8 pm. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Nov. 22, 2024, at 8 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Nov. 22, 2024, at 8 pm will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday Dec. 2, 2024, will receive a full refund.

Move-ups

Written (or emailed) move-ups prior to the trial will be accepted until 6:00 pm on Mon, Dec. 2, 2024, by sending: **Your Name, Dog's Name, class entered and which class moving to. DAY-TO-DAY MOVE-UPS** for the following days, must be submitted in writing in the notebook provided at the score table within ½ hour of the last run of the trial day.

X-pens and crates may be left over night, but the GLKC will not be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No grooming is allowed in building and no dogs may be left overnight. One Judge/ One Ring each day. Agility Ring is: 90' x 100' indoors on artificial turf. Electronic timing will be used. Agility Gate will be used.

The building will be open for 30 minutes past the last run of the day.

** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations for the state in which they are competing.

Worker Sign-Up

GLKC appreciates our workers! An online worker sign up like will be sent to all those entered in the trial. Volunteer workers will receive "GLKC Credit" commensurate with class size/classes worked, which may be used for entry fees on future GLKC trials or classes. Water and light snacks will be available for workers. We are sorry we are unable to offer lunch.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO will be open for all classes. Participation in FEO is nonqualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

These changes will become effective on July 1, 2024.

- Allow For Exhibition Only (FEO) in all classes.
- No longer require the Pause Table in the Excellent and Master Standard classes
- No longer require a "Bar" jump in any courses. This jump type has 2 bars on it.
- Only allow one time use of the tire. Tires must have a straight approach to them and then on departure.
- Allow the use of a Wall Jump in Excellent and Master classes to add obstacle variety.
- Increase the course yardage allowed in Jumpers With Weaves at the Excellent and Master levels for all heights (and corresponding Preferred heights).
- Reduce wheeling of Open courses to one time.
Increase the course yardage allowed for 8- & 12-inch heights (and corresponding Preferred heights) for the Excellent and Master levels.

As of January 1, 2021, Fix and Go On will be offered. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a nonqualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class (dogs must qualify to receive a placement). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Double Q ribbons will be awarded. A PAX rosette will be awarded to those dogs earning one at this trial. A MACH/PACH bar and rosette will be awarded to those dogs earning one at this trial. A Grand Champion will be awarded a rosette, bar, and \$100 in vouchers for a future trial at this trial. Exhibitors are asked to notify the trial chair if you could possibly earn the title at this trial. All dogs finishing a title will receive a New Title ribbon. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

Classes

Class: Levels offered in Standard, JWW, and FAST class

Regular: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent/Master

Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent/Master

Time 2 Beat: All classes (Novice, Open, Excellent/Master) run the same course
Premier Standard and JWW: Regular and Preferred

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Jump Height Divisions

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in all of the classes.

Regular Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

Preferred The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	REGULAR	PREFERRED
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches at the withers	24 inches	20 inches
Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretion.		

Table Heights

GLKC will be using the updated AKC table heights, effective January 2, 2018:

8 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.

12 Inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.

24 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

Dogs may not be entered in this class if they are 22 inches and under.

24 Inch Choice: Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches and under at the withers.

Height Cards

Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**** NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

* Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.

* All dogs **MUST** be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump. Crating space is limited, please crate in designated areas only.

* There may be no more than **10 dog entry forms** per envelope. Express Mail entries must include YOUR signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address or they will be refused

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.

* Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries WILL be returned. Fill in all the blanks, please.

* Refunds: A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason, when the request is received by the Trial Secretary in writing or via email prior to closing date.

After closing and prior to the start of the trial, entry fees less \$8.00 per run will be refunded for injured dogs or injured handlers. After closing and prior to the start of the trial, entry fees less \$5.00 per run, will be refunded for bitches in season. A doctor/vet's letter may be required for injuries or bitch in season, at the discretion of the Trial Committee.

Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason. **No refund will be given for overpayment of less than \$10.00** Checks returned from your bank will incur a \$20 charge and all future entries must be paid with a money order or cashiers' check.

* In accordance with *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, no dogs under the age of 6 months are allowed on the show site. All AKC rules apply regarding toys and food in the ring.

* If you include an email address, you agree to be contacted about your entry and will check it in a timely manner.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
